We've taken on board the many film suggestions shared by members and are delighted to include a number of these in the forthcoming programme. Recently, a small group of us met to plan the new season and, with two new additions to the FalFilm team, we're excited to offer an even broader and more varied selection of films.

We are also introducing at least six additional Friday evening screenings under the banner of *Alternative FalFilm*. These will focus on less mainstream films and will be introduced with a short talk or pitch by Mark Rivers, who originally came up with the name FalFilm.
